Arrivals on the 8th of June

We'll wait for you at the airport and at the train station. No worries: it will be easy for you to recognize us ☺

Arrivals before the 8th of June

We won't be at the airport or at the train station to wait for you: apologies for that, but we have to prepare the tournament! So, please follow the following instructions to reach the hotel (Westotel Nantes Atlantique - 34 rue de la Vrière 44240 La Chapelle sur Erdre).

❖ **From the train station to the hotel**

You have to take the “**tram-train**” Nantes – Chateaubriand, **direction Chateaubriand** and get off the train at “**La Chapelle Erdre Active**” station.

- ① To do so, exit the train station, and walk towards the “tram-train” station on your right. Just follow the signs!



- ② At “La Chapelle Erdre Active” station, cross the railroad. Be careful!



- ③ Follow the street, straight ahead! You'll see the hotel!



❖ **From the airport to the hotel**

Airport is served with airport shuttles. It's a direct link Airport / train station / city centre. There's a bus every 20 min and it takes 20 min to go to the train station.

When you arrive at the train station, please follow the instructions above ☺

Transport by train

Some workers of the French railway company (SNCF) are still on strike and Thursday 7 and Friday 8 June are currently expected to be strike days (but not Sunday 10 and Monday 11 June).

For those of you who want to join Nantes by train (SNCF, OUIGO, Thalys, Lyria,...), it's sure that all the trains (TGV, Intercités) that are still open for booking will run.
